

NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of \$.275767 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Frio Hospital District.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$ <u>.275767</u> per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$ <u>.275767</u> per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$ <u>.298240</u> per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2021 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Frio Hospital District from the same properties in both the 2020 tax year and the 2021 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Frio Hospital District may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Frio Hospital District is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2021 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 16TH, 2021 AT FRIO REGIONAL HOSPITAL AT 200 IH 35 S, PEARSALL, TEXAS, 78061.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Frio Hospital District is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Frio Hospital District Board of Directors at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE TAX RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{tax rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$

The 86th Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by Frio Hospital District last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by Frio Hospital District this year.

No-New-Revenue Tax Rate Adjustments

Indigent Health Care Compensation Expenditures

The Frio Hospital District spent \$2,183,915.28 from July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021, on indigent health care compensation procedures at the increased minimum eligibility standards, less the amount of state assistance. For the current year, the amount decrease from last year's enhanced indigent health care expenditures is \$1,997,966.30. This increased the voter-approval tax rate by \$.00513.
